DOST-MIMAROPA SHOWCASES S&T SERVICES AND TECHNOLOGIES AT BAGONG PILIPINAS SERBISYO FAIR

THE Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through DOST-MIMAROPA, actively took part in the Bagong Pilipinas Serbisyo Fair (BPSF), where it showcased a range of Science and Technology (S&T) programs and services to Mindorenos. The event included exhibits, technology forums, online review sessions for the S&T Scholarship program, and free calibration services.

The BPSF is the Philippine government's biggest service caravan aimed at providing major government services to Filipinos. The recent leg of the BPSF was held at Oriental Mindoro National High School (OMNHS) in Calapan City from March 9 to March 10, 2024.

The BPSF kicked off with an opening ceremony, during which participating government agencies recognized and awarded grants and assistance to various beneficiaries. As part of the ceremony, DOST-MIMAROPA ceremonially granted assistance to four (4) beneficiaries of the Small Enterprise Technology Upgrading Program (SETUP) and one (1) beneficiary of

the Community Empowerment through Science and Technology (CEST) program.

Throughout the two-day celebration, an exhibition of DOST programs and services was featured, including SETUP, CEST, S&T Scholarships, STARBOOKS, and the Regional Standards and Testing Laboratory (RSTL). Additionally, various technologies were showcased, encompassing water technologies, Solar Energy Systems (SES), Automated Rain Gauge (ARG), and digitalization technologies. These technologies included platforms such as mimaropaventures.ph, Artificial Intelligence-based Management for Disaster Risk Evaluation and Monitoring (AIM-4DREAM), EH2O: water quality monitoring system, as well as several sales and inventory management information systems developed by DOST-MIMAROPA in collaboration with MIMAROPA SUCs.

Simultaneously, an online review session took place for the upcoming DOST Undergraduate Scholarship Program applicants.

To promote DOST's testing and calibration services, DOST-MIMAROPA provided a free weighing scale calibration to public market vendors, MSMEs, cooperative members, and bakery owners, who heavily rely on accurate weighing equipment for daily operations. A total of 39 weighing scales from 14 different firms across 8 municipalities in the province were calibrated during the event.

Training sessions were also conducted to include Training on Current Good Manufacturing Practices and Technopreneurship. The Training on Current Good Manufacturing Practices was attended by owners and employees from various firms in the province. Participants were educated on the basic of food quality assurance and ensuring compliance with product quality standards. The Technopreneurship Training covered topics on the significant role of technopreneurs in the economy and utilization of technologies to enhance processes, products, services, and marketing.
