DOLE MIMAROPA SPEARHEADS KASAMBAHAY ADVOCACY CAMPAIGN IN ROMBLON PROVINCE

TO capacitate barangay officials in promoting the rights and privileges of domestic workers, the Department of Labor and Employment MIMAROPA conducted a series of Kasambahay Advocacy held at the Municipal Hall of Magdiwang and Gymnasium of Odiongan on May 15 and 17, 2024 respectively.

On May 15, DOLE MIMAROPA held its first leg of orientation at Sibuyan Island, attended by the Punong Barangays (PBs) of the municipalities of Cajidiocan, Magdiwang, and San Fernando. And, on May 17 at Tablas Island participated by the PBs of LGU Alcantara, Calatrava, Ferrol, Looc, Odiongan, San Agustin, San Andres, Santa Fe,

and Santa Maria.

Prior to the discussion, Regional Director Naomi Lyn C. Abellana uttered a message emphasizing the significant roles of Brgy. Chairpersons in handling and resolving issues involving the domestic workers in their community. Also, she briefly discussed the rights, wage-related benefits, and prevailing minimum wage rate of domestic workers in the region which is equivalent of P5,500.00.

RD Abellana reiterated that barangay can seek help from DOLE thru the Public Employment Service Office (PESO) in their respective municipality.

Technical Support and Services Division

(TSSD) Chief Marjun S. Moreno comprehensively discussed the salient features of Republic Act No. 10361 or also known as Batas Kasambahay. He expounded the mandate of the Department in safeguarding the welfare of household workers, protecting them against all kinds of abuses, and ensuring that they are covered with mandatory benefits as members of the labor force.

Meanwhile, DILG Local Government Operations Officer II Florid John Gonzales facilitated the discussion on Registration of Kasambahay, ensuring that house helpers have full protection of the law.

SERBISYONG TAMA PARA SA BARANGAY PUTING TUBIG


